We at PA Treatment & Healing are committed to educating our students and providing a quality distance education. In order to do this in the most effective way, PATH will be lending out materials to students in order to complete coursework. Students will be asked to submit online work as well as returning paper based work on a bi-weekly basis when possible.

A laptop is being assigned to your student to help them complete any online work. Please understand that if the laptop and charger assigned is not returned in **GOOD** working condition, you will be required to pay a replacement fee of \$150.00

Free Write Journaling - This is a time that will count as a daily english grade. During this turbulent time, students are encouraged to write their thoughts and feelings. If students are struggling to think of anything to write, a daily topic will be posted on google classroom if they choose to use that. Students will write each day in a Google Doc (posted through Google Classroom) and will receive attendance credit in addition to an English grade for their responses in the document. Each separate response must be dated!

PE Time Outside! - We encourage students to spend time outside (weather permitting) doing activities such as going for a walk, taking a bike ride, playing basketball, walking your dog, playing catch with your siblings, or riding a scooter.

Electives - The following can be chosen to work on during elective time; Current Events, Technology, Forensic Science, Career Readiness. Assignments for each option will be posted at the beginning of the week and students may work on them during elective time, completing one assignment each elective time period

IXL - Time utilizing IXL daily is a requirement and will be monitored closely. This program gives students reinforcement work that is critical to their success in their core English and Math courses. For the first week of home instruction students will be working on “Diagnostic” testing to establish levels. In order to do this, the student will login in with their IXL information (see computer information sheet) and click “Diagnostic” at the top middle of the page, followed by “Enter Diagnostic Arena” and must continue to attain present levels for each category (completed levels will be marked with a ★). Once levels are finalized, students will be assigned specific lessons that are Math or Language Arts focused through announcements made on google classroom.
